

The proceeds provided athletic scholarships for the college. Since its inception in 1962 the Bruin club has contributed nearly \$3 million to MCC athletics. The established goal at MCC is excellence in all fields, including athletics which has had a long and highly successful history.

- Nearly \$3 million raised for athletic scholarships since 1962
- Annual recognition of community members who have contributed to athletics in Flint and Genesee County
- Numerous camps and clinics for area youngsters
- Purchased buses to provide transportation for athletic teams
- Updated the Genesee Room in the Prahl Center on Mott's Campus
- Updated a room in the Ballenger Field house and called the Blamer Room.
- Purchased such items as a computer, printer, P.A. system, nets for inside ball practice, and furniture
- Purchases warm-up suits yearly for all athletes
- Helped purchase new score boards and table
- Purchased new score board for Whaley Park & Kearsley Park
- Purchased Infield Groomer and trailer for Kearsley Park
